Mrs. Emma M. Flippen "Bigmama" was born March 17, 1935 in Lumber Bridge, North Carolina; the daughter of the late Neil and Rosie Mae Malloy. Emma resided in Red Springs, NC until relocating to Flint, Michigan in the 1960's. While in Michigan, she was employed with General Motors Chevy Manufacturing, a division of General Motors, until retirement. Emma became a faithful member of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church, where she sang in the Choir and was a servant on the Usher Board until her health began to fail.
