Mr. Ernest J. "Bro" Horton was born May 18, 1943 in Flint, Michigan, the son of Evergene Luckado and Ernest Horton, Sr. At the early age of 11 years old his other father Will T. Fleming came into his life. He was raised and educated in Flint, Michigan, attending Parkland Elementary, Emerson, Jr. High School and Northern High School. He was employed at Truck and Bus Assembly a division of General Motors, retiring in 1999 after over 30 years and was a member of UAW Local 598. In the early 1960's Mr. Horton boxed in the Golden Gloves in the light and heavy weight division. He trained under Floyd Fielder at Burston Field House and then went to the state finals in Grand Rapids, MI. Mr. Horton had a passion for music. He had a collection out of this world of over 3,000 albums. Mr. Horton enjoyed cutting hair, sports, and teaching someone a lesson in dominos down in his man cave "The basement." He never met a stranger and had a great personality.
