Ernestine moved to Flint, Michigan, when she was 16 years old and remained in Flint throughout her adult life. She graduated from Central High School. She later received her certification as a Licensed Practical Nurse and worked at Hurley Hospital. She was married to Lemon Williams for a period of time in the 1950's. Later, she shared life with her longtime companion, Charles Ross.
