Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11 a.m. Friday. Mrs. Riddle will lie in state in the Sanctuary of Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, and may be viewed Friday, during family hour only. Mother Essie Mae Riddle was born in Muskogee, Oklahoma, the daughter of William and Elizabeth Sallis. Mrs. Riddle was united in Holy Matrimony 54 years to the late Samuel L. Riddle, Sr. Upon moving to Flint they made Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church their church home, where she served actively and faithfully for over 35 years. She leaves to cherish her memory: daughter, Norma Jean Jefferson; sons, Samuel L. (Barbara) Riddle, Jr. and Thomas E.
