



Mrs. Estella Price

June 10, 1915 - October 30, 2020

PRICE, Mrs. Estella - Age 105, passed away Friday, October 30 at her residence. Mrs. Price will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Monday. After which she will be taken to Verbena, Alabama where services and interment will be held.

Estella Price entered into this earthly realm on June 10, 1915 in Verbena, Alabama. She lived to be 105 years, 4 months, and 20 days old. She was the oldest of six children to Rayfield and Ellen (Posey) Ray. Her father affectionately called her “boy” because of her work abilities in the fields and handling of the livestock.

Estella married at the tender age of 14 years old to Robert Price. To this union two children were born - Moses Price and Mary Magdalene (Price) Peoples, whom she loved dearly. As fate would see it, her marriage didn't last and as a single woman, Estella headed north to look for better employment opportunities to take care of her children, as well as to provide financial assistance to her widowed mother and her children, Moses and Mary. Cincinnati, Ohio became her temporary home until the failing health of her mother resulted in her moving back to Verbena, Alabama to care for her mother until her death.

Estella was a faithful believer of the Word of God and she was a praying woman who would correct you in love. She was a dedicated member of Pentecost Methodist Church; now known as Hope United Methodist Church in Verbena, Alabama. She would walk to church even when she was well into her 90s. She was an active member and held the position of church mother before she relocated to Michigan.

Mrs. Price was a stylish woman who loved to have her nail polish match her outfits. She polished her nails daily until she was 102. She was an entrepreneur, selling harvest from her crops, eggs from her chickens, and strawberries out of her strawberry patch. She also had a great love for flowers, ice cream, potato chips, Pepsi Cola, bingo, and her home state of Alabama.

In 2008, after being diagnosed with dementia, Mother Price reluctantly moved to Michigan to reside with her daughter, Mary. While in Michigan, Mother Price loved the Lord and continued to fellowship at Mount Sinai Missionary Baptist Church (Pastor Morris Collins) and Harris Memorial Church of God in Christ (Pastor Eric C. Bogan) but was quick to tell you she was a Methodist girl and her Pastor was Reverend Samuel Nelms.

Her legacy includes 6 granddaughters: Wanda (Larry) of Florida, Laura Jean (Victor) Robertson of Flint, Paulette Price of Texas, Lawaner Price and Della Price of Flint, Arnenia Odum of Burton, MI, and Pastor Monique Roland of Battle Creek, MI; grandsons, Carl Parker of Flint and Pastor Anwan (Kimberly) Roland of Grand Blanc, MI; daughter-in-law, Claudy Price of Verbena, AL; 28 great-grandchildren; 30 great-great grandchildren; sister, Clara Graham of Birmingham, AL.

Mother Estella Price loved all her family, including special nieces, Gloria Bates of Hinesville, GA and Ashley Thomas of Birmingham, AL; nephew, Beannie

(Bridget) Graham of Ypsilanti MI; cousins, Alma Holyfield, Diana Postell, Terry Cooper, Lisa O'Bryant, and Dewayne White, whom she affectionately called "Red Man."; adopted son, Robert (Annie) Peoples of Flint.

Estella was preceded in death by her parents: Rayfield & Ellen Ray; children, Moses Price and Mary "Mag" Peoples; grandsons: Kevin Peoples and Moses Price, Jr.; brother, Wilbert Ray; sisters, Ezella Washington, Zola Bell Smith, and Prezella Logan.
