Mrs. Estella Williams attended and graduated from Industrial High School. She went on to marry Mr. Morgan Searcy and to this union 3 sons were born, Thomas, Morgan Jr. and Reginald Searcy. The family moved to Flint, Michigan where she worked and retired from AC Spark Plug, a division of General Motors.
