Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:00 AM Thursday. Mrs. Vanderson will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. A time to be born ... Esther Genell Knapp Vanderson was born December 27, 1951 in Jackson, Mississippi, the daughter of Percy Sr. and Nellie (Knapp) Willis. Esther grew up in Jackson, MS attending elementary school, Powell's Junior High, and graduated from Brinkley High School in 1970. While growing up, she attended Vernon Grove Baptist Church. During her course of Junior High and High School, she discovered her gift of sewing and began sewing her wardrobe. Esther joined the "Voices of Faith Choir" and traveled all over the United States, she also designed and sewed many of the choir's uniforms. After graduating from high school in 1970, she started college at Jackson State University and graduated in 1973 with a Bachelor Degree in Elementary Education. She also joined the Burns Seventh Day Adventist Church in Jackson, MS. While attending college in July, 1970, Esther came to

Flint, Michigan to visit her mom and siblings and was introduced to Edward S. Vanderson, who would become her soul mate. How the soul mates got together is a story in itself. The courtship began from Flint to Jackson and the love letters flowed. After graduating from Jackson State University, Esther moved to Flint and on August 27, 1972, she was married to Edward S. Vanderson. Esther started substitute teaching for the Board of Education in 1973 and she became tenured with the Board of Education in 1986. She continued to fellowship in the Adventist Faith until she joined Fairhaven Seventh Day Adventist in Flint. Esther was a part of the "Fairhaven 5:00 a.m. Prayer Group" and a member of the Federated Kings Daughters. She continued her education at Eastern Michigan University graduating with a Master's Degree and Highest Honors in 1991. In June 1975, Edward and Esther welcomed their daughter, and in 1980 they had a son. Esther loved family and friends. Over the years she hosted many family and friends gathering at her home. In hosting, it had to be perfected in Esther's way. She created her own sewing patterns and sewed many masterpiece including wedding gowns that were never duplicated. In 1983 she sewed her sister's wedding gown. The fabric store tried to buy the wedding gown back for display. Esther would not sell. She also prepared food for serving at church until her health failed. In spite of her disability, she was able to mime with the "Hands of Praise."

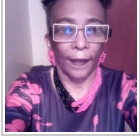
