Mrs. Ethel Hill confessed her life to Christ at an early age. Ms. Hill united with Antioch Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Rev. L.W. Pryor. She served on the Senior Usher Board and was a true tither and faithful member until her health wouldn't allow her to go to church. Ethel Hill was very active and a hard worker in many auxiliaries of the church. She was also a faithful member of the Elks Lodge. Ms. Hill married James Gunter and to that union one daughter was born, Geraldine Gunter. She worked at General Motors Fisher Body #1 and retired in 1974. She was a member of Local 581. The "Mink Lady" also loved working at Clyde Burtrum Furs for many years, until her health failed. Her customers and co-workers were very special to her. Whenever she had a little energy, she would often help the church auxiliaries and friends with style shows and programs. Ms. Hill worked with civil leaders, in her community, and with her friends, always giving of
