Born May 2, 1936 in Oxford, MS the daughter of Allie V. Howard and Belma Mitchell. She accepted Christ at a very early age and throughout her life she remained a true believer in Christ and proved to be a true servant of God and loving mother, grandmother of all her offspring and everyone around her. At the age of 18, on October 11, 1954 she united in marriage to Willie Robinson, Jr where together they bore four children before relocating to Flint, Michigan in 1962.

In her early years in Flint she was a stay at home mom raising her children during that time she managed to complete her high school degree and continued her education at David’s school of Cosmetology where she earned a degree focusing on one day becoming a beautician and make-up artist. She then opened her business at home as a wig stylist called Ethel’s Wig and Styling and renewal service for seniors with the logo being “Don’t Throw your old wigs away! Let them see another Day! She serviced her neighborhood on

the South side of Flint with numerous clients in the surrounding area. In 1968 she was hired into General Motors where she worked at the V-8 engine plant on the T-4 line for thirty-years before retiring. From then she along with her grandson Rapheal attempted to write a book about her life story as a child growing up in Mississippi a dream that would never manifest into a reality. But she pushed on and perfected her ability as an artist and was very good at that endeavor as well.

Ethelene continued to follow her dreams after retirement to attempt to travel the world onto travel a few states in the US. Like Vegas, Atlantic City, Hawaii, Florida etc..... She loved the bus trips with her friends to these places while selling her Avon products and Tupperware. She enjoyed casino's, hanging with family and friends, Barbeques, Card games, graduations, Birthdays, dancing, listening to music like jazz, blues and even big band music. She was always the one that was characterized as the life of the party always saying that you only live once, so let the good times roll! Her bond was always closer to the younger generation because she said older people was boring. She didn't hold back on whatever she wanted to say and she said a lot. 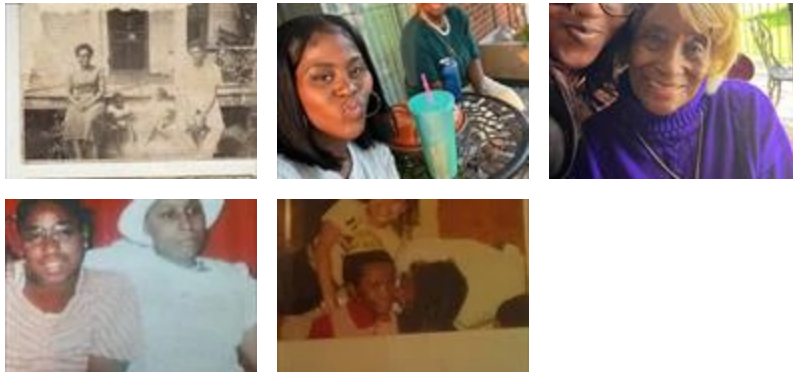

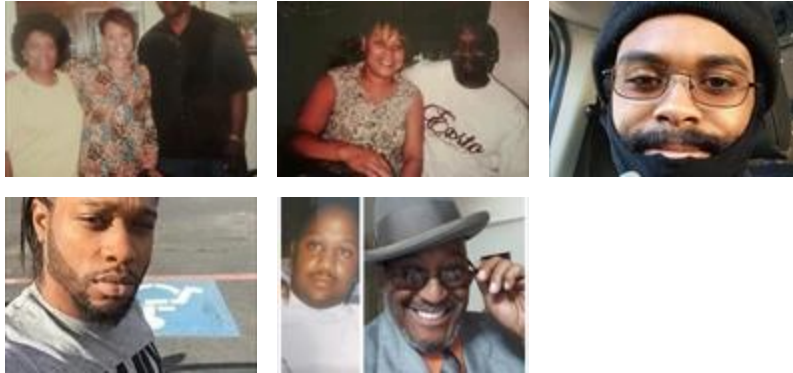
