Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Mrs. Eula Mae Maclin was born on September 6, 1920 in Memphis, Tennessee, the daughter of Eules and Annie Mae (Carrieker) Jenkins. Eula gave her life to Christ at an early age. She resided in Arkansas and Tennessee prior to relocating to Flint in 1947, where she united with the Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. On February 14, 1956 she was united in Holy Matrimony to Cornelious V. Maclin. Shortly thereafter, she joined the Foss Avenue Baptist Church, under the pastorage of the late Dr. Avery Aldridge, and was an active member of the Senior Choir and Nurses Guild. Eula was educated in the Arkansas and Tennessee school systems and was a domestic caregiver for over 60 years. She enjoyed cooking, cleaning and nurturing her family. She was the family caregiver for many years, caring for her mother, husband, 3 brothers, and 1 sister, until God called them home.
