Mrs. Eula Mae Pressley, age 91, of Grand Blanc, Michigan, passed away peacefully on May 12, 2025, at Tranquility House AFC, a family business owned and operated by her daughter. She was surrounded by her loving family and the long-time staff of Tranquility House AFC.

Eula was born on November 1, 1933, in Tallulah, Louisiana, the eldest daughter of Willie Branch and Eran "Shang" Taylor. She graduated from Carroll High School in Monroe, Louisiana, in 1954 and later earned her bachelor's degree in Elementary Education from Grambling State University in 1960.

After relocating her family from Los Angeles, California, Eula began a fulfilling

career with the Flint Board of Education. Her passion for nurturing young minds led her to the classroom, where she uplifted students and colleagues alike with her quiet leadership, compassion, and unwavering belief in the power of education. Her entrepreneurial journey began early, when she and Charles Sr. co-owned “Williams’ and Pressleys’ Furniture Company” with her sister’s family.

A devoted resident of Grand Blanc, Michigan, Eula lived a life rooted in faith, service, and love for her community. For over 50 years, she was a faithful member of Vernon Chapel AME Church, where she served in numerous roles with unwavering dedication and a heart full of grace. Her presence in the church was not only consistent but foundational, touching lives across generations with wisdom, kindness, and spiritual strength.

Eula was married to Charles Pressley Sr. for 16 years before they divorced. From that union came three children: Charles Jr., Cassandra, and Christopher, as well as three cherished grandchildren from Cassandra: Natasha Redford, Ricardo Wilson, and Breanna Wilson, who were—and always remained—the pride and joy of her life. Her love for us was constant, unconditional, and deeply rooted in her belief in family.

Outside the classroom and church, Eula was a woman of vision and enterprise. She was a proud member of the Flint NAACP and served under her sister’s administration for 15 years as a Chairwoman and Barbara McClendon and Dr. Douglas Wright serving as Co-Chairpersons. She remained actively engaged in civic life, campaigning for local political candidates and supporting causes that promoted justice and equality. Her creativity came to life through sewing and arts and crafts—each handmade piece a reflection of her care and unique flair.

After 26 years and 91 days as an educator, Eula retired in 1995, her dedication to children continued. She opened and operated a daycare, creating a nurturing and loving space where the youngest members of her community could grow and thrive.

Her entrepreneurial spirit was unmatched. Whether managing real estate,

selling handmade merchandise, or running her beloved food truck—where she served General Motors employees and Flint residents—Eula approached every endeavor with purpose, integrity, and a deep sense of community. She had a rare gift for blending creativity, business, and service in everything she did.

Her life was a vibrant testimony to faith in action, lifelong learning, and love without limits. She gave endlessly—to her family, her church, her students, and her community—and the impact of her legacy will be felt for generations to come.
