Mrs. Evester Louise Darrough was born January 25, 1945 in Pine Bluff, AR. to the late Eunice and Dorothy Williams. A graduate of Townsend Park High School, Evester earned the Bachelor of Science Degree from Agricultural, Mechanical & Normal College (A.M & N.), now the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff. In 1984, Evester received the Master of Science Degree in Reading from Eastern Michigan University in Ypsilanti, MI. Evester pursued further study in the field of education at the University of Michigan in Ann Arbor, Michigan to complete teacher certification for the state of Michigan. She retired from the Michigan Board of Education in June 2002, where she had been employed as both an elementary school teacher and a federal programs evaluation supervisor for 29 years. Evester was a member of the New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church, where she was a member of the Deaconess Ministry and a member of the Adult Sunday School class. In the Flint community, Evester was an active member of the American Business
