She earned her Bachelor's Degree from Baker College of Flint, in Business Administration. Fay was a dedicated worker for H&R Block for many years, provided services to (VITA) Volunteer Income Tax Assistance, the Food Bank of Eastern Michigan and also served as a foster parent. She was currently employed with Holmes Middle School c/o AmeriCorp as an Education Coordinator and was very passionate about her students, especially those that just needed a little extra love! She was a previous member of Eliezer Apostolic Church, under the direction of Bishop & Mother Raymond Dunlap. Currently, Fay attended Community Impact Church under the leadership of Pastor Corey James. In 1979 Fay married the love of her life, Duane, at Church of Jesus Our Lord. 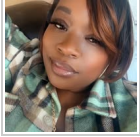

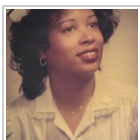
