Mrs. Flossie Mae Penigar was born on March 13, 1932 in Hampton, Arkansas, the daughter of Eugene and Cordia Ashley. Flossie was a resident of Flint, MI for 47 years. She was united in marriage to Marvin T. Penigar and to this union were five children. Flossie was a very dedicated worker and a provider for her family. She retired from Buick, a division of General Motors after many years of service and was a member of UAW Local 598. Mrs. Penigar was a long time member of Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church where she later moved on to be a faithful member of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Church where she served on the Missionary Board.
