Mrs. Dixon will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday, with the family present from 6:00 PM - 8:00 PM to receive friends. Mrs. Floyda Janice (McClinton) Dixon was born December 26, 1931, in Hughes, Arkansas. She was the 3rd of 4 children born to the union of Ira and Carrie (Smith) McClinton.

Floyda began her education at Lakeview Community School in Lakeview, Arkansas and met the love of her life Charles Henry Dixon at Arkansas AM&N (currently called Arkansas State University). Charles and Floyda were united in marriage on January 7, 1954.

Mr. and Mrs. Charles Dixon moved to Flint, Michigan in 1955 and to this union was born 3 sons, Fred, Rudy, and Vincent. Charles and Floyda were married for 53 years until Charles made his transition.

Floyda accepted Christ at a early age and joined St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church where she participated in the Choir, Mission Ministry, Mother's Board, Sunday School, Kitchen Supervisor and Great Lakes District Minister Wives. She was a faithful member of St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church for more

than 50 years.

Floyda worked at the Fair Store in the South Flint Plaza and graduated from the Mott College of Nursing with a Licensed Practical Nurse Degree. She began working at Hurley Medical Center as a LPN in 1969 and retired in 1990. Throughout her life she enjoyed cooking, shopping, bowling, family gatherings and traveling.
