February 5, 1943 - August 19, 2008

Muse-Sibley, Mrs. Frances E. - Age 65, was called back home on Tuesday, August 19, 2008 at Genesys Health Park. Family hour 6-8PM Monday, August 25, 2008 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Muse-Sibley to earth entrusting her care to her parents, Johnie and Mary Muse. In 1961, Frances graduated from Flint Northern High School, after which, she attended Mott Community College. She was an active member of New Zion Missionary Baptist Church, where she served on the Nurses Guild. She was also a former member of New Jerusalem Full Gospel Baptist Church. Frances was employed at the Flint Board of Education for several years, where she met some of her closet and most dearest life long friends. She retired in 1995 from the Genesee County Sheriff Department as a Deputy on the Observation Unit. In this capacity, she served on many committees including the executive board of Deputy sheriff Local Union 2259, the Genesee County Jail Morale Committee and the Committee for the Mental Health for Inmates. Frances was instrumental in establishing and implementing policies for dealing with inmates with mental health concerns when relocating to the new jail. She was a member of the Flint Neighborhood Coalition and a secretary for Northland

Gardens Block Club. She also participated in the HOST program and Title 1 program and was a member of Grandparents and Career Day Committees for Beecher School District. She enjoyed shopping, cooking, playing the lottery and watching sports. Frances was lovingly nicknamed, "The Warden" as she was Ms. Bossy.
