TAYLOR, Mr. Franklin - Age 87, passed away Sunday, November 22, 2020 at Regency of Chene, Detroit, MI. Mr. Taylor will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed Monday, November 30, 2020 from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM. Interment Great Lakes National Cemetery, G-4200 Belford Rd., Holly, MI. Mr. Franklin Delano Taylor was born May 22, 1933 in Milan, Tennessee, the son of Horace Taylor and Elvie Reeves. Franklin was a Veteran of the United States Army and served in the Korean War. He was a member of Foss Avenue Baptist Church for the past 57 years, under the leadership of the late Dr. Avery Aldridge and current Pastor, Dr. Reginald G. Flynn. Franklin served on the Deacon Board and Usher Board where he served as Usher Board Director for more than 45 years. He retired from Flint Metal Fabricating, a division of General Motors Corporation after working 43 years as a Crane Operator. Franklin enjoyed watching Western movies, CNN News, reading the Bible and talking about Jesus Christ. He also enjoyed socializing with the guys at McDonald's daily over coffee until his mobility decreased. Franklin most enjoyed spending time with his only son and grandson.

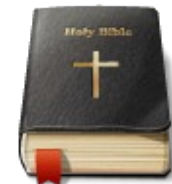
