June 3, 1927 - October 7, 2011

SHACKELFORD, Mr. Fred "Happy" - Age 84, passed away Friday October 7, 2011 at Genesys Regional Medical Center. Family Hour 1:30 p.m. Saturday October 15, 2011 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., with funeral service commencing immediately at 2 p.m. Pastor Reginald G. Flynn D.Min, officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 1:30 p.m. Saturday. Mr. Shackelford will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home and may be viewed from 1-8 p.m. Friday with family present from 5-8 p.m.

Mr. Fred "Happy" Shackelford was born June 3, 1927 in Wyville, Arkansas, the son of William H. and Cleo (Stewart) Shackelford. "Happy" proudly served in the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict and was Honorably Discharged. On July 9, 1945 he married Rosie Lee Wilborn in Little Rock, Arkansas. In 1955, he moved his family to Flint, Michigan, where he began employment at General Motors Flint Truck and Bus Assembly Plant and was a member of UAW Local 598, retiring after 35 years of service. "Happy" was also a Barber by trade.
