BOOTH, Mr. Freddie Lee Sr., - Age 57, passed away Wednesday, August 30, 2017 at Augusta University Medical Center-Augusta, GA. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday. Mr. Freddie Lee Booth Sr. was born on June 5, 1960, the son of Major Sr. and Cora Lee Booth. Although originally from Little Rock, Arkansas, the family moved to Flint, Michigan where he graduated from Beecher High School, "Class of 1979." Mr. Freddie Lee Booth Sr. was a God fearing man and was a member of Church of Trinity Pentecostal. Beside church he enjoyed spending time with his family, fishing with his close friends and cooking, better known for his BBQ Sauce. Freddie also enjoyed riding his motorcycle. He was a member of the Sonz of Zodiac MC since 2008 where he retired from Presidency in 2015. Freddie Lee was employed as a Security Guard from Beecher School District and began Truck Driving the 18 Wheeler (he loved being out on the road).

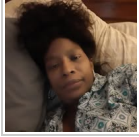
