Shortly after moving to Flint, he gained employment with Fisher Body, a division of General Motors while living with his Aunt Dora and Uncle Oscar Barnett. In 1966, he married and fathered two sons, Frederick and Corey. Freddie was most recently employed at Securitas Security Agency, Inc., USA.
