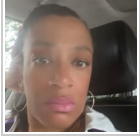

“ Frederick Oneal Haywood, age 80, of Atlanta, Georgia, died Sunday morning, September 27, 2020 at his home surrounded by his family. Born June 6, 1940 in Greensboro, North Carolina. Frederick spent his early years living with his Grandmother Bennie, while his mother Rosa Bell Haywood (Washington) joined his father at several posts during his service in the Army Air Corp. Following World War II, the family moved to New York City before eventually moving to Flint Michigan. A star football player, Frederick graduated from Flint Central High School in 1959. Upon graduation, Frederick attended Farris State University where he continued playing football.

In 1961 Frederick met the love of his life Rosetta Roberts. A two-year courtship preceded an elopement. According to Fred, “For all the wrong things I’ve done, I got one thing right. I Just want to thank my wife for putting up with me.” While the family started to grow, Fred attended Mott College, played semi-professional football (the Sabers), and worked as machinist at AC Spark Plugs. In the ensuing years, Fred accepted a position with the Buick Division of General Motors in the early years of computer technology. Eventually, Fred would retire as a Systems Analyst with Electronic Data Systems

Frederick and Rosetta are the proud parents of three beautiful daughters. Referred to as an “OG Girl Dad”, by his youngest, Fred was a steadfast fan of ballet recitals, school plays, and taught his girls how to fish, cut grass, as well as drive, all while loving them unconditionally. He took extreme pride in his grandchildren and was an instrumental figure in the life Gwendolyn Majette, Melanee Roberts, Eloise Jones, and grandson, Craig Delmar Sutters.

Fred was an exemplary husband, father, and grandfather. Both spiritually strong and compassionate, Fred had a clever sense of humor. A true Man’s man, Fred was exceptionally well rounded. An avid fisher and hunter, Fred loved the outdoors. His hobbies included but are not limited to sports, photography, jazz, gardening,

reading, motorcycles, and cycling.

At the birth of their first great grandson Caleb Commerse, Frederick and Rosetta moved from Flint to Atlanta, GA. As Fred posted to Facebook, "I miss the four seasons and all my friends that are still here. We found a nice little house just for two. we also enjoy our children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. We had to be near the kids, and they have been great. I must go to the Y, just to keep moving. I found a new friend (Arthur Jones) that reminds me so much of Jimmy Jones. God is good." 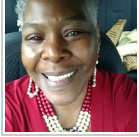
