EVANS, Mr. Fredric Elias - Age 68, passed from this world into God's Kingdom, Monday, May 30, 2011 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Evans was born February 14, 1943 in Muskogee, Oklahoma, to the parentage of Fredric G. and Henrietta Evans. Fredric was a resident of Flint since the family's arrival in 1945. He attended Flint Public Schools, graduating from Flint Central High School, "Class of 1962", where he enjoyed playing football. Mr. Evans was also a U.S. Army Veteran and served during the Vietnam War. He was employed at Buick Motor Division as a Journeyman Carpenter until his retirement and was a member of UAW Local 599. In recent years, Mr. Evans had experienced a series of physical challenges and setbacks yet his sense of humor always remained intact. He loved fishing, playing pinochle, watching sports and listening to good music. For most of his entire life "Fred" as he was affectionately called, had a deep, abiding love, for his family and siblings. "Fred" will be greatly missed by all, both family and friends who knew and loved him. He leaves to cherish his memory: wife, Shirlie; beloved children; 2
