She was raised and educated in Birmingham, AL including years at Miles Community College and later Mott Community College (Flint). She met her husband Sherman Jackson at Western High School. The couple moved to Flint, both finding immediate job opportunities.

Fredritha Brazil Jackson's vocations always centered around children including Michigan Head Start, Martin Elementary School and Mott Children's Health Center. Fredritha worked for Model City, Beecher Schools and Whaley

Children's Center. She eventually accepted a position at Michigan School for the Deaf and Blind where she served for 36 years until her retirement.

Prior to departing this life on Monday June 16, 2014, she was married to Sherman for 52 years, they raised 2 daughters together and she was a devoted grandmother. Her hobbies included reading, knitting, crocheting, sewing and SHOPPING!

Mrs. Jackson was preceded in death by 2 brothers and a sister.
