Frenchetta accepted Christ at a very young age. She was a faithful member of Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church. She previously served in various auxiliaries including, the Junior Usher Board, BTU, the Young Adult Choir and the Highlight Gospel Chorus. Mrs. Davis was a current member of the Women of Wisdom (W.O.W.) and the Total Praise Fellowship Choir. Frenchetta graduated from Flint Southwestern High School, "Class of 1975." Shortly thereafter, she attended Michigan State University, where she was a member of the Black Orpheus Choir. She also attended and graduated from Hurley School of Nursing in 1979. Mrs. Davis was a Licensed Registered Nurse. Prior to retirement in 1993, she worked at Hurley Medical Center as a Staff Nurse, Assistant Head Nurse and at the Hurley/Northwestern School Clinic.
