Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30a.m. Saturday. Mr. Hodges now lies in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12noon-8p.m. today. Mr. Fritz Drexel Hodges was born August 24, 1954 in Flint Michigan. Fritz was the son of the late Randall A. and Lila B. Hodges. Fritz had been a life long resident of Flint. He served in the United States Marine Corps. He was an all around sportsman. Sports accomplishments included: Flag Football National Championship (1984), starting third baseman for Flint Northern Varsity Baseball Team, and enjoyed all card games. Fritz was selected to attend Interlochen Summer Music Camp while a member of the Flint Northern Choir. He was asked to sing the Northern Alma Mater (Acappella) at his 30 year reunion.
