LEAVY, Mrs. Geneva - Age 79, passed away Saturday, November 12, 2005 at Hurley Medical Center. Family hour 10:30AM Friday, November 18, 2005 at Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, G-5443 S. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Thursday. Sis. Geneva Leavy was born on January 9, 1926 in Yazoo City, Mississippi, the daughter of the late Tom and Annie Coleman. Sis. Leavy united in Holy Matrimony to Bro. Perry Leavy on September 22, 1946, and became a resident of Flint in 1955. Upon their arrival to Flint, she united with the Macedonia Missionary Baptist Church, under the leadership of the late Rev. Ira Watkins. She previously served as Secretary and Teacher in the Sunday School Children's Division, and later, as a faithful member of Sunday School and Wednesday Morning Bible Study class until her illness prevented her from participating. Sis. Geneva was also a former member of the Melody Chorus of Macedonia, the P.T.A. of Martin School, and a Cub Scout Den Mother. For many years she served as Chaplin for the V.F.W.
