



Mr. George Gregory Mattison V.

MATTISON, Mr. George Gregory V. - Age 76, passed away Sunday, May 17, 2026 at his residence. Family hour 10:30 AM Saturday, May 30, 2026 at Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church, 3502 Lapeer Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11:00 AM Dr. Rabon L. Turner Sr., officiating. Interment River Rest Cemetery, G4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10:30 AM Saturday. Mr. Mattison will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Friday.

Mr. George Gregory Mattison V was born August 31, 1949 in Anderson, South Carolina, the son of George L. and Dorothy B. Mattison. George migrated to Michigan with his parents at a young age and graduated from Northern High School in 1967. He then attended and graduated from Michigan State University where he received a Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice. During college and after graduation he worked at Genesee County Legal Aid and Insight Recovery as an Addictions Counselor.

In 1983 he began his 25-year career at United Way of Genesee County where he served as the Executive Director of Campaign Finance. George was a tireless fundraiser and actively involved in the Greater Flint philanthropic community. He raised millions of dollars for Genesee County families needing assistance and programs that assisted youth in the community. Additionally, he was often recognized by his peers for his dedication to local non-profit

fundraising and for coming up with innovative campaigns to raise money for the community such as “Bottles for Babies”.

George was a faithful son who came to visit his parents every day after work and assisted them in the upkeep of their home until he was unable to do so. He joined and was a faithful member of Grace Emmanuel Baptist Church where he was the Co-founder and Chair of the Grace Emmanuel Community Outreach (GECO) committee. George greatly enjoyed putting his gift for philanthropic work to use in the Lord’s kingdom by serving on the committee for many years.

In 1967, George joined the Phi Eta Psi Fraternity, Inc. and was chosen as the Imperial Man of the Fraternity in 1968. He served as President of the Grand Chapter from 1997 to 1998.

Mr. George G. Mattison V leaves to cherish his memory: 2 sons, Sean Banks of Ohio and Chaunce (Taniesha) Reid of Flint; grandchildren, Savon and Shanden Banks, Santino and Emilio Reid; brothers, Kenneth D. Mattison of Flint, Creon B. (Tawanda) Mattison of Grand Blanc, Tracy F. Mattison of Columbia, TN; sisters, Yvette (Dr. Kenneth) Bray of Grand Blanc, and Dr. Tammalette Mattison of Columbia, TN; a host of cousins, and other relatives and friends.

Mr. Mattison was preceded in death by his parents, George L. and Dorothy B. Mattison, and sister, Shriene.
