Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Friday. Mr. George W. Young was born September 28, 1946 in Flint, Michigan to Mrs. Pearl M. Young and the late George Young. He gave his life to Christ at an early age and grew up in New Zion Baptist Church. George attended Flint Public Schools and graduated from Southwestern High School in 1964. Upon graduation he joined the United States Marine Corp where he served for two years. After receiving an honorable discharge, he attended Mott Community College. He was employed by General Motors for 41 years becoming a skilled tradesman at Chevrolet Truck & Bus. George Young believed that service to others was the price we paid for living in this world. Therefore, he served as a trustee of Mt. Olive Baptist Church, a volunteer/mentor at Pierson and Gundry Schools and as a Big Brother for several years. He was a life member of the NAACP. George's passions were working, traveling and dining at five star or ethic restaurants. He visited most of the United States including Hawaii. He spent weeks in India, China, Thailand, Japan/Hong Kong, Italy, Spain, France, Canada and the Caribbean.
