Georgia Mae Summers, age 106, passed peacefully through Heaven's gate on Monday, April 22, 2019. Her physical body will be in River Rest cemetery next to two of her sisters, Caridad and Marquita. Georgia was born in Anniston, Alabama, February 17, 1913. After graduating from Barber Memorial Seminary, she attended Hampton Institute for one year. As a young adult, she moved to Chicago, Illinois and in 1953 joined St. James A.M.E. Church. She was a Torch Bearer in the Missionary Society for over 30 years and during her membership was a leader of Y.P.D. and Recording, Financial and Correspondence Secretary. When her sister's, Marquita, health began to fail, she moved to Flint in 2007 and affiliated with Quinn Chapel A.M.E. Church. Always active, Georgia was a skilled bridge player, a talented seamstress, an avid photographer and she loved to travel! Besides touring all

over the continental United States, she ventured to Canada, Hawaii, the Far East, Mexico, the Scandinavian countries, many western European countries and The Holy Land. She truly planted the seeds for travel and photography in her niece, Camille.
