(Perry) Coleman. "Gerry" as she was affectionately called by her brothers, sisters, and other family members, often said, "I'm just a jack of all trades, and master of none." This indeed was not the case. In fact, Geraldine mastered many things in her time. Not only did she raise 9 children, she graduated from Flint Central High School one year early due to high academic achievements. She also received a scholarship to attend, Bakers Conservatory of Music (Currently Bakers College) for her musical talents, which included: mastering, the violin, piano, organ, "B-Flat" tenor saxophone, and playing with the Flint Symphony Orchestra.
