ELLIS, Mr. Gregory B. Sr. - Age 68, passed away Thursday, December 26, 2024 at Durand Senior Care. Family hour 11:30 AM Saturday, January 4, 2025, at Greater First Timothy Ministries, 2131 Eberly Rd., with Memorial service commencing at 12:00 PM, Elder Joe Torreano, officiating, Pastor Timothy Franks, Eulogist. Family and friends will assemble at the Church 11:30 AM Saturday. There will not be a public viewing. Gregory Blake Ellis Sr., a talented musician and devoted servant of God, was born on February 14, 1956, and transitioned, leaving behind a legacy of faith, music, and service that inspired countless lives.

Gregory's passion for music began early, inspired by his grandfather, Herbert "Spike" Miller, a touring musician with the Ringling Brothers Barnum & Bailey Circus. While attending Clark Elementary School, Gregory mastered the drums, violin, and vocal performance, later adding the vibraphone in junior high.

In 1973, Gregory started his formal musical education at home and attended the Flint Michigan Institute of Music from 1975 to 1976, where he refined his skills on the keyboards, saxophone, trombone, percussion instruments, and vocals. At just 16, he began performing in nightclubs, earning a reputation as a gifted and versatile musician. Gregory collaborated with gospel legends such as James Cleveland, The Winans, Twinkie Clark, and Commissioned. Locally, he played alongside artists like Maurice Davis and Larry McCray, leaving an indelible mark on Michigan's music scene. His talent and

generosity fostered lifelong friendships and enriched the lives of fellow musicians. Gregory also valued education and practical skills. A graduate of Northwestern High School in 1974, he pursued training in automobile mechanics, small engine repair, air conditioning, and refrigeration, demonstrating his commitment to excellence in all areas of life.

Gregory's faith was central to his life. At St. George Bethel Church of God in Christ, he served as a deacon, drummer, and YPWW President. He also played drums for New Heart Church and Greater First Timothy Ministries under Pastor Timothy Franks for over a decade. In his later years, he attended Greater Grace Ministries, continuing his dedication to worship and service. Gregory's life reflected his favorite scripture: "Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord" (Colossians 3:23). Whether mentoring, performing, or supporting his church through service, Gregory's hands and heart were always dedicated to God's work. Gregory Blake Ellis Sr. leaves behind a legacy of love, music, and unwavering faith that will be cherished by his family, friends, and all who knew him. Gregory will be deeply missed but forever remembered for his extraordinary talents and devotion to serving others.


