He was also Owner/Operator/Mechanic and Broker of his own Trucking Business "Holley Enterprise Inc." Harley worked with many companies hauling for various industries; minerals, steel, trees, and produce across the United States. He was a family oriented, strong exemplary man with great work values. Harley inspired, motivated, encouraged and mentored many young men over the years.
