JENNINGS, Deacon Harold "Papa" - Age 88, passed away Wednesday, October 1, 2008 at his residence. Family hour 11AM Wednesday, October 8, 2008 at New Israel Missionary Baptist Church, 3417 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 12Noon, Rev. Daniel Bridges officiating. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11AM Wednesday. Deacon Jennings will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Tuesday. Deacon Harold "PaPa" Jennings was born November 2, 1919 in Rocheport, Missouri, the son of the late Howard and Stella Jennings. He was the second out of three children. Deacon Jennings was a member of New Israel Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Deacon Board. He was also a member of the Civilian Conservation Corps, where he enrolled July 7, 1939 at the age of 18 in Fulton, Missouri as a Laborer, he was discharged September 13, 1939 to return to school and finish his education. "Papa" worked for General Motors, retiring October 1, 1981. He enjoyed fishing, reading the newspaper, sitting outside enjoying the children and his loved ones. "Papa" was a wonderful man.
