WALKER, Mrs. Harriette Callie - age 83, passed away Saturday, March 22, 2014 at Briarwood Manor. Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, March 29, 2014 from the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Interment Flint Memorial Park Cemetery, G-9506 N. Dort Hwy., Mt. Morris, MI. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the funeral home 10 a.m. Saturday. Mrs. Walker will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, and may be viewed from 3 p.m.-8 p.m. Friday.

Mrs. Harriette C. Walker (Callie Marshall) was born March 28, 1930 in Jackson, TN. She was the only daughter of her loving parents Gloria Mayo and Harvey Marshall. Her family moved her to Saginaw, MI at an early age where she was educated in the local Christian schools and she received an Associate's degree from college.

She met and married Harry J. Walker on September 25, 1950 in Saginaw, MI and they were married for 61 years before he passed away. From their loving marriage they had four children: Orlanda of Flint, Vincent of Wilmington, DE, Timothy of Newark, DE and Phillip of Flint. She had 8 grandchildren and 3 great-grandchildren.

She was a courageous woman who shared her love with everyone. She never met a stranger. One of her goals in life was to empower young people and uplift women. She loved people, pets and politics.
