On April 23, 1943 he joined the United States Army, where he served his country well, as a Technician Fifth Grade during WWII and was Honorably Discharged on January 9, 1946. After the war he moved to Saginaw, Michigan in search of work and that is also where he met his wife, Callie Marshall (Harriette C. Walker). They were married for 61 years as of Sept. 5, 2011. From their loving marriage they had four children.
