LeFLORE, Mr. Haskel - Age 75, passed away Monday, May 27, 2013 at his residence. Mr. Haskel "Ray" LeFlore was born April 10, 1938 in Peno, Oklahoma, the son of William and Evia (Smyers) LeFlore. After graduating from Flint Northern High School in 1956, his following year he enlisted with the U.S. Navy where he served for four years before being Honorably Discharged. In 1966, Haskel married Ernestine Peoples and to their union were added Lolita Antoinette, Michael Ray, and Sherry Lynette Leflore. After the Navy, Haskel was employed with General Motors as a skilled trade's worker and served as a Union Representative, with strong belief in workers' rights, until his retirement in 1992. As a huge sports enthusiast, some of his hobbies included baseball, football, boxing, and swimming. His favorite pastime was spending time with his grandchildren and socializing with his friends.
