LeFLORE, Mr. Haskel "Ray" - Age 75, passed away Monday, May 27, 2013 at his residence. LeFLORE, Mother Ernestine - Age 74, passed away Wednesday, June 5, 2013 at Genesys Health Park. Mother Ernestine LeFlore was born November 12, 1938 in Moscow, Tennessee, the daughter of Neely and Amelia (Wright) Peeples. She moved to Flint to be closer to her sisters at the age of 19 and worked as a childcare giver until she was hired into the Paramount Potato Chip Company until her retirement in 1992. She was married to Haskel LeFlore for 47 years they added three children to their union. Lolita Antoinette, Michael Ray, and Sherry Lynette. At the tender age of 28, she accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior and joined Pentecostal Tabernacle C.O.G.I.C., where she served for many years on various auxiliaries. In 2003, she joined Harris Memorial C.O.G.I.C. (under then Bishop Walter E. Bogan and later Pastor Eric Bogan) where she served on various committees and auxiliaries within the Women's Department. Mother LeFlore's hobbies included happily fervently serving the Lord,

gardening, and spending time with her family. Mother's most favorite pastimes included intercessory prayer, being an Evangelist of Christ spreading His Word, and traveling to various church functions.

After the Navy, Haskel was employed with General Motors Service Parts Operation as a skilled trade's worker and served as a Union Representative, UAW Local 659. Haskel had a strong belief in workers' rights, he retired in 1992. Ray was a huge sports enthusiast, some of his hobbies included baseball, football, boxing, and

swimming. His favorite pastime was spending time with his grandchildren and socializing with his friends.
