Haywood accepted Christ as his personal Savior at an early age at Leighs Temple in Hartford, NC. Haywood was Veteran of the U.S. Army, and served from 1963 until he was honorably discharged in 1966. He received a Good Conduct Metal and several other awards. After relocating to Flint, he became employed at General Motors Corporation. He retired in 1991, after 25 years of service and was a member or UAW Local #599. Haywood was united in marriage to Willie Mae Lang in 1969 and together they had five children. Haywood served as former President of The Flint Eagles Motorcycle Club, and was a founding member of the Gentlemen of Soul and Super 10 Clubs, specializing in social gatherings and events.
