The family moved to Flint, Michigan when she was 15 years old. Hazel graduated from Flint Northwestern High School in 1972. Several years later she returned to school to pursue a higher education. Mrs. Yearby received a Bachelor's of Arts degree in Management from Detroit College of Business in 1988. For several years Mrs. Yearby was employed as a substitute teacher with the Flint Community Schools. More recently she worked with GCCARD teaching Microsoft applications. Since the founding of New Flint Neighborhood Programs/S.T.O.P. Team in 1987, Mrs. Yearby was actively involved and worked in the development and implementation of a variety of youth programs. She accepted Christ as her personal savior at a young age. She has been a dedicated member of Evergreen Missionary Baptist Church for the past 26 years where she was a Sunday school teacher and a member of the
