BIGGS, Mr. Henry C. - Age 76, passed away Thursday, December 13, 2007 at his residence. Family hour 10AM Friday, December 21, 2007 at Mt. Calvary Missionary Baptist Church, G-4805 N. Mr. Henry Clay Biggs, Sr. was born August 18, 1931 in Lumberton, Mississippi, the son of Marclite Biggs and Robert Pledge. Mr. Biggs graduated from Booker T. Washington High School in Memphis, Tennessee. In 1953 he came to Michigan, where he was employed at Fisher Body as a Master Craftsman, retiring in 1976. He was also a member of UAW Local #581. Mr. Biggs gave his life to Christ at an early age attending Mt. Calvary M.B.C. until his health failed. His hobbies included fishing, baseball, listening to music, traveling with his family, riding motorcycles, and driving his van and boat.
