Mr. Henry Thomas Lawson “PAP” was born March 15, 1923 in Utica, MS, the son of the late Henry Lawson and Willie Bell Epps. Henry confessed Christ in August 2008. He served in the U.S. Army in 1948, where he was Honorably Discharged. He married Mary Taylor in 1942 and to this union two children were born, Angela and Tammy Lawson. Mary Lawson died April 13, 1997. Henry later married Shirley Lea July 31, 2009, they had one son, Darryl Lea. Henry was very big on family and would do anything for them.
