



Deacon Henry Lee Rankin

May 3, 1942 - October 11, 2014

RANKIN, Deacon Henry Lee - age 72, passed away Saturday, October 11, 2014 at Genesys Health Park-Grand Blanc, MI. Family hour 10 a.m. Saturday, October 18, 2014 at House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church, 1851 W. Carpenter Rd. with funeral service commencing at 11 a.m. Pastor Kenneth L. Stewart officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Association, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10 a.m. Saturday. Deacon Rankin will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd. and may be viewed from 12 p.m.-8 p.m. Friday.

Deacon Henry Lee "Workhorse" Rankin began his journey of life on May 3, 1942, in Waynesboro, MS. He was the son of the late Sylvester and Annie Lee Rankins. He attended the Wayne County School District and graduated from Riverview High School C/O 1961. In 1966, he relocated to Flint, MI and began working for General Motors and became a Supervisor at Fisher Body. He was a very dedicated worker and rendered faithfully for 33 ½ years and retired in 1999. On October 10, 1987, he was joined in Holy Matrimony to Ann Brown, with this union they were blessed with two sons. Deacon Rankins accepted the Lord as his Savior at an early age. He served on the Deacon Board and sang in the choir at Magnolia Missionary Baptist Church of Waynesboro, MS. He loved the Lord and was committed to do his will. Upon arrival to Flint, MI, he joined Mt Hermon Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Albin Henry. He later moved his membership to

New Jerusalem Missionary Baptist under the leadership of the late Bishop Odis A Floyd. There he served as a Deacon and sang in the choir recording two songs, Yes Lord and Well Done. Min. A. Jeffery LaValley stated, "Rankin was faithful, supportive and an example as a choir member to others". In 1985, he joined Second Friendship Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Anderson Fields where he served as Chairman of Deacon Board for a number of years and a Lead Singer of the Gospel Chorus and Male Chorus. He was also the Youth Choir Coordinator. In 1999, he joined House of Prayer Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Kenneth L. Stewart and served on the Deacon Board and remained a member until his death. Deacon Rankins was affiliated with several gospel groups though out the years. He began singing with Doves of the South in Waynesboro, MS at 16 years old. After moving to Flint, he sung with the Flint Allstars, Paramounts, Southern Trumpant, Guiding Lights, Gospel Southerners and The Flint Cavaliers. The Flint Cavaliers CD "Live in Concert" was released in 1999 with the hit song, "Have You Ever Been Burden", which was #11 on the Top 20 Gospel Billboard Chart. The Flint Cavaliers CD was also nomined for a Stellar Award and Soul Train Award. The Cavaliers toured the East Coast, West Coast and South appearing on stage with Canton Spiritual, Shirley Caesar, Mighty Clouds of Joy, Jackson Southerners, Lee Williams, William Brothers, Doc McKenzie, Will Neal Johnson and Gospel Keynotes, Lumzy Singers, Bolton Brothers, Spencer Taylor and Highway QC's, Five Blind Boys and many other Gospel artist. Deacon Henry L. Rankins was truly a LEGEND in his own time.

Deacon Henry Lee Rankin "Workhorse" leaves to cherish his precious memories to his devoted and loving wife Ann Rankin. 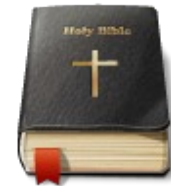
