Mr. Strozier attended Flint Northern High School until he began his service in the United States Army. He served during World War II from 1943 to 1946. He was a decorated veteran who earned numerous awards of valor including the Bronze Star Medal. He worked at Flint Fisher Body, a division of the General Motors Corporation. He retired from the company after 31 years of faithful service. He was a member of Antioch Missionary Baptist Church. In his youth, he enjoyed fishing and Gospel singing.
