BOND, Mr. Herman - Age 86, passed away Sunday, April 23, 2017 at Kith Haven Nursing Home. Family hour 11:00 AM Saturday, April 29, 2017 at North Central Church of Christ, 2001 N. Saginaw St., with funeral service commencing at 12:00 PM Bro. Rigel Dawson Host Pastor, Dr. James E. Thompson officiating. Interment Sunset Hills Cemetery, G-4413 Flushing Rd. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 11:00 Saturday. Mr. Bond will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 4:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday.

Mr. Herman Bond known by family and friends as “James Herman” was born June 29, 1930 in Brownsville, Tennessee, the son of Roscoe Sr. and Ora Mae (Lee) Bond. He grew up on a farm. His mother who was known for her beauty, passed away when he was 4 years old. His father was a Farmer his entire life and a Brick Mason passed away at the age of 63, when he was 13 years old. “James Herman” soon went to live with his first cousin, Andrew “Bud” Bond and wife, Florence. He was baptized at the age of 13 at Beech Grove Church of Christ in Brownsville, TN. His first job was at the church cleaning the building, lighting the firewood to provide heat, he was paid a generous salary of \$4.00 a week. Herman attended Luster Elementary School and Carver High School, after which he served in the Korean War. After his discharge he attended Tuskegee Institute in Tuskegee Alabama. He later moved to Flint, Michigan and attended General Motors Institute where he received his

Journeyman, skilled in Welder Maintenance. On December 25, 1955 (Christmas Day) James Herman married his high school sweetheart, Ola June (Jones) Bond at her home in Stanton, Tennessee and to this union 5 children were born, 1 son and 4 daughters. He retired from General Motors in 1985 after working 31 years in skilled trades. Herman was business minded and a family man. He owned and operated H&R Trucking, working with his son, Roscoe, providing materials for landscaping at homes and businesses. Herman also plowed snow for various businesses throughout the Flint area, and he owned many rental properties. He enjoyed traveling, camping with his family across the United States and Canada, stopping to fish along the way. "James Herman", a Christian man was one of the first Elders appointed at the North Central Church of Christ. He served as a Trustee, Superintendent and performed baptisms at North Central for 34 years. Herman loved the Lord, enjoyed studying the Bible, his favorite sayings, "Put God first in everything you do" "Do what thus sayeth the Lord" he loved to sing, one of his favorite songs: "May The Work I've Done Speak For Me."

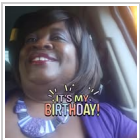

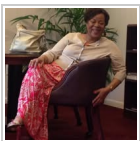

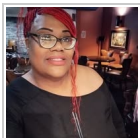
