Hezekiah graduated from Flint Northern High School, "Class of 1941", where he won state champ in hurdles in 1940. Hezekiah served in the United States Army from 1941-1946, where he was in the Anti Aircraft Aviation Division, where served as a Tuskegee Air Cadet. He later attended Baker Business College, and co-owned and operated Bibbs and Son's Interior Decorating. Hezekiah was employed at GM, with 42 years of service. He was a 33rd Degree Mason and the Knights Templar. Hezekiah was an avid reader, loved to travel and spend time with his family. Mr. Hezekiah S.
