Horace attended Booker T. Washington High School, graduating in 1940. He entered the United States Army in 1942 and was Honorably Discharged as Staff Sergeant in December of 1945. Horace was united in Holy Matrimony to Miss Elnora Batts on April 7, 1953 in Washington D.C. He was a faithful member of the Christ Fellowship Usher Board, Great Lakes District Usher Board, and Christ Fellowship Baptist Church Sunday School Class #10. Horace was employed by the City of Flint Parks and Recreation for 20 years, retiring in February 1986. He was a member of the Tucker and Ward Family Club.
