RUSHING, Mr. Hosie - Age 70, passed away Tuesday, June 17, 2008 at Maplewood Manor in Clio, MI. Family hour 10:30AM Saturday, June 21, 2008 at Promise Tabernacle, 815 W. Hosie received Jesus Christ as Lord and joined the Promise Tabernacle family in 2005. He attended Flint Public schools and was a graduate of Northern High School "Class of 1958". Mr. Rushing served in the United States Army where he received an Honorable Discharge. Upon returning home, he gained employment at Chevrolet V-8 Engine Plant – a Division of General Motors for 30 years. Hosie's hobbies included listening to jazz, watching the Food Network, cooking and observing others as they enjoyed his delicious cuisine while refusing to divulge the secrets to his recipes.
