Deacon Howard Cuba was born May 11, 1934 in Rison, Arkansas to the union of Mr. and Mrs. Sidney and Susie (Ridgeway) Cuba. Upon graduating from Lanwood High School, Howard relocated to Flint, Michigan and matriculated at Mott Community College. Howard was employed as a Skilled-Tradesman at Grand Blanc Metal Fabricating, a division of General Motors Corporation, working as a Millwright and was a member of the UAW Local #1292. He retired in January of 2000 after 44 years of service. Howard met and married the love of his life, Bernice Miller, on August 28, 1965, whom he loved and cherished for 49 years, to this union one son was born. Deacon Cuba was a man that loved and feared the Lord; he was a godly example at home, at church, and in the community. Deacon Cuba enjoyed studying the Word of God and ministering to others. He joined Harris Memorial Church of God in
