WILLS, Mr. Hozell - Age 82, passed away on Saturday, July 23, 2005 at McLaren Regional Medical Center. Family hour 10AM Friday, July 29, 2005 at First Union Baptist Church, 7004 Fleming Rd., with funeral service commencing at 11AM. Rev. Archie Powell, Jr. officiating. Interment Lovedale Memorial Cemetery, 5175 E. Bristol Rd., Burton. Friends and pallbearers will assemble at the church 10AM Friday. Mr. Wills will lie in state in the Chapel of Lawrence E. Moon Funeral Home, 906 W. Flint Park Blvd., and may be viewed from 12Noon-8PM Thursday. Mr. Hozell Wills was born on May 8, 1923 in Bastrop, Louisiana. He graduated from high school in Louisiana in 1940. At the age of 19, Hozell joined the United States Army, serving in the 101st Airborne Unit in the early 1940's. After being Honorably Discharged in 1950, Hozell became a resident of Flint, MI. He retired from General Motors in 1987, with over 30 years of service at Fisher Body B.O.C. in Grand Blanc, MI, and he was a member of UAW Local #1292. Hozell was an active fisherman and hunter, who enjoyed being outdoors, cooking, being around his favorite people, listening to blues music and watching movies. He raised 1 daughter, Maggie Jones and two of her children, Walter R. Jones, Jr. and Patricia M. Wills.
