She was a member of Metropolitan Baptist Tabernacle where she served with the Christ Alive Ministry and faithfully attended Sunday School until her health prevented her from doing so. Ida retired from AC Spark Plug, a division of General Motors in 1991 after 31 years of service and was a member of UAW Local 651. She was also an active bowler with various leagues throughout the city.
